Among the girls, tennis is the most popular and half of them like it. Fifteen girls like soccer. Basketball is more popular than baseball. Among the boys, thirty students like baseball. The same number of students like soccer. Basketball is more popular than tennis. Twenty boys like basketball. Favorite sports between boys and girls at this school are very different.

I stayed there for ten days from December 26 to January 4. It was winter in Japan, but in Australia it was summer. I went to a summer school in the morning and studied English there. Many students came from different countries. It was very nice to meet different people.

I stayed with Mrs. Johnson and her family. The summer school started at 8:30 in the morning. In Japan, my mother always cooked breakfast for me. I thought, "Mrs. Johnson will cook breakfast for me." But she said, "Mika, you have to make your own breakfast." At that time, I thought, "She is not kind to me." I started to cook my breakfast. Ten minutes later I finished cooking it.

On the third day, I was watching television. It was very hot. So I said to Mrs. Johnson, "I want something to drink." But she said to me, "Mika, go to the kitchen and get something to drink." Again I thought, "She is not kind to me."

When I came back to Japan, I talked to my English teacher from Australia about Mrs. Johnson. I said to the teacher, "Mrs. Johnson wasn't kind to me because she asked me to make my own breakfast and get something to drink." He said, "I don't think so.
