問題のしかく1は聞き取り検査です。この検査は問題Aと問題Bの2種類に分かれています。途中でメモをとってもかまいません。解答はすべて解答欄に書きなさい。

それでは、問題Aについて説明します。

これから、中学生のJimとMikiの対話が英語で2回読まれます。表のかっこ1からかっこ5に入る答えを日本語で答えなさい。

では始めましょう。

Jim: Hi, Miki. How are you?

Miki: I'm fine, thank you, Jim. And you?

Jim: I'm fine, too.

Miki: By the way, we will have a festival on August eleventh. I'm going to go to the festival with Mary and Hideki. Would you like to go with us?

Jim: Oh, that's wonderful. I would like to go with you.

Miki: We'll be happy if you come with us, Jim.

Jim: I'll be happy, too. Where will you have the festival?

Miki: We will have the festival in a park. The park is near my house. We will start walking from my house at six forty-five in the evening. Ten minutes later, we will arrive at the park. We will wait for five minutes in the park and the festival will start.

Jim: OK, I'll meet you at your house at six forty-five. See you then, Miki.

Miki: See you, Jim.

それでは、問題Bについて説明します。これから、日本でホームステイをしている中学生のNancy Stewartが、自分の体験に基づくスピーチをします。その後にスピーチの内容について、かっこ1からかっこ4の英語の質問が読まれます。かっこ1とかっこ2については、それぞれの質問の答えを指示に従って、英語で答えなさい。かっこ3とかっこ4については、それぞれの質問の答えを、英文で答えなさい。また、かっこ5の英文は、Hanakoが使った「もったいない」という言葉の意味を、あなたがNancy Stewartに説明すると仮定したものです。問題用紙の空欄に、6語以上の英語を入れて英文を完成しなさい。英文は、本文、質問と読まれた後に、もう一度本文と質問が繰り返されます。途中でメモをとってもかまいません。

I am Nancy Stewart. I came from America two weeks ago. I now live in Okayama with a Japanese family called Hayashi. Hanako is the grandmother in the family. I like her because she is kind to me. She is interested in English. She can understand me if I speak English slowly. Today I am going to talk about the thing I learned from her. One day I wanted to talk with Hanako. So I went to her room. When I went into her room, I found a lot of short pencils in a box on Hanako's desk. I said to her, "Excuse me, Hanako. Can I ask you a question?" Then she said, "Of course, you can." I said, "Why do you have these pencils in your box, Hanako? They are short pencils." Then she thought and tried to say something in English, but she couldn't. She said slowly in Japanese, "*Mottainai*." I thought, "What is *mottainai*?" I didn't understand the meaning of the word at that time. I will stay in Japan for another week. I hope to understand its meaning during my stay.
