問題B 次の会話が2回読まれるのを聞いて、問題用紙の指示に従って答える。

Mr. Brown: What do you want to do when the students from Singapore come to our school on August 20<sup>th</sup>, Sakura?

Sakura : I think it is a good idea to show the Singaporean students some club activities in our school. One of my friends is a member of the dance club and another friend is a member of the music club. Both of them want to do something for the Singaporean students on that day.
