


英 語 (45分)

注意1 日本語の字数が指定されている問題では、「、」「。」も1文字と数えます。

2 英語の語数が指定されている問題では、「.」「.」「.」「.」「.」「.」などの符号は語数には入れません。また、「don't」などの短縮形は1語とします。

① この問題は聞き取り検査です。問題A、問題Bに答えなさい。

問題 A Takashi は昨年の春にイギリス研修に参加して姉妹校のある町に滞在し、ロンドン (London) やケンブリッジ (Cambridge) にも行きました。帰国後に作ったアンケート結果について校内英語プレゼンテーション大会で、グラフ (Graph) 1、2を用いて報告しています。発表を聞いて、①～⑤に答えなさい。問題は2回読れます。



① 姉妹校においてTakashiが驚いたことは、次の(1)～(4)のうちではどれですか。一つ選び番号で答えなさい。

(1) The teachers gave the students difficult questions.

問題B 校内英語プレゼンテーション大会後、イギリス研修に参加したAkiが留学生のBobと教室で会話をしています。①～④についてそれぞれの質問文の答えとなる英文を 内に指定された語数で完成しなさい。問題は2回読されます。

① Do Bob's Japanese friends use furoshiki?

... 3語.

② Why did Aki buy her host family furoshiki?

... Because she knew furoshiki 4語 when she went to Kyoto.

③ How did her host father try to use furoshiki?

... He tried to put furoshiki 6語.

④ What does Aki want to do?

... She wants to 4語 of using furoshiki.

2 Taro の高校では、掃除は放課後に班ごとに割り当てられた場所で行うことになっています。Taro の班は、今週は教室掃除の担当で、Taro は班員の Kana や Kenji と会話をしています。英文を読んで①～④に答えなさい。

Taro: Well, everyone, it's time to clean our classroom.

Kana: Some members are not here today.

Kenji: Again? I don't think they want to clean our classroom.

Taro: That's a big problem. All the members should be here and clean the classroom together. Yesterday, I had to carry more than twenty desks and chairs with Kenji. It was very hard.

Kenji: I understand you, but will they really join us when we tell them to do so? (ア) . It's better to do things with people who want to do them.

Taro: I don't agree with you, Kenji. It's our duty.

Kana: Taro, they may have something important to do after school. I understand that, but I am angry with them because they left our classroom without telling us why they did so.

Taro: Kana, even when they have something else to do, they have to clean the classroom. There is no excuse.

Kenji: Taro, I think it's better to clean the classroom with people who want to do it. The most important thing is to make the classroom clean.

Taro: We need more time to do things with fewer people. (イ) . There are things we have to do even when we don't want to do them. If some students don't do those things, the people around them will not believe them. They should know that. I think all the students in our class should share the problem about the cleaning activity and try to find the best way to solve it. This is very important.

Kenji: I just want to clean the classroom and study in a beautiful place. We can ask them to join the cleaning activity, but they may not help us a lot. They may clean unwillingly or play in the classroom. We'll need more time to clean the classroom with such students.

Taro: Kenji, our problem is not how quickly we finish the cleaning activity. It is how all the members join it. We have to do some things, even when we are very busy with another job. We have many important things to do in our school life. (ウ) .

Kana: If they are busy after school, we can ask them to do things they can do. For example, they can empty the trash bin after lunch.

Kenji: Well, we have talked a lot. Shall we start now?



3 次の英文を読んで①～⑤に答えなさい。

My name is Ayumi. I'm sixteen. Every spring and summer, I visit my grandma and stay with her for three or four days. She now lives in a small and quiet village. It is very far from my house. She takes care of flowers and vegetables in her garden. Early in the morning, she walks around in the garden and picks some fresh vegetables of the season for her table. She enjoys her simple life very much.

One of the greatest joys in her life is gardening. She grows many different kinds of flowers in different seasons. During the day, she takes hours to walk around in the garden to cut off the weeds and give water to the flowers. She often picks some favorite flowers and puts them in a lovely vase in her room.

On a beautiful spring day, when I was walking with her in the garden, she said, "It's nice and warm, and birds are singing merrily. Look at those flowers, Ayumi. They are very beautiful." I said, "Yes, they are, Grandma. When I visit you, I am always excited to see many kinds of wonderful flowers and plants in your garden. Even on rainy days, you go out there and take good care of them. Why are you so interested in gardening?" "Because it gives me joy and courage in my life," she said with a smile on her face. "Courage?" I said to myself. It was (ア) at that time, but I didn't ask her.

When we were eating dinner, she said, "Ayumi, I have a story to tell you. (イ)a / who / is / with / woman / it / about / lived her dogs and other animals in a small and old-fashioned house. She became very interested in growing flowers when she was very young. She also liked drawing pictures. Then, she decided to live on a farm and draw pictures for the rest of her life. It was her dream from childhood. She believed that she could get great happiness and freedom by (ウ)doing so. In her new farm life, she began to write children's books and draw illustrations for Christmas cards to get money for her living. She gradually became known as a writer and painter all over her country. Then she moved to another place to build her own garden because she loved gardening most. She used much of her time to take care of her garden and lived a simple and old-style life there until she died. She also became very popular as a gardener."

My grandma's story continued, "I want you to remember (エ)the woman's words, Ayumi. In her books and interviews, she says as follows: Life is short, so you should do the thing you love to do most. You can get true happiness if you have a feeling of satisfaction in your heart. When you feel your life isn't interesting, you should try hard to find something fun and beautiful around you. It is there, and you can find it. But remember that it often takes a lot of time. It is very important that you should keep trying hard until you can find it. It isn't good to give up soon." "Ayumi," she said. "When I am walking around in my garden, I always feel happy to find something new and exciting there. Flowers and plants, and even small birds and animals can show me how to find it. They show me that they are trying hard to live and grow every day." After she finished her talk, I was very moved and came to like her garden much more. Then I understood what the word "courage" meant.
